Policy:

1. No child under sixteen years of age will be left alone waiting for a ride outside a LCPLS facility at closing.
2. Children under sixteen years of age will be turned over to the police or sheriff's office if they are not picked up by a family member within twenty minutes past closing time.
3. Children nine years of age and younger may not be left in a LCPLS facility without the specific permission, on a given day, of the senior library staff member on duty.
4. Children nine years of age and younger left in LCPLS facilities without permission of the senior library staff member on duty will be turned over to police or sheriff's office for disposition.
5. Any minor requesting assistance with a ride at closing time will be given an opportunity to call a family member for pickup and will be turned over to police or sheriff's office if no ride is forthcoming by twenty minutes past closing time.
