**A PROCLAMATION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS,
LEVY COUNTY, FLORIDA RECOGNIZING NOVEMBER, 2016 AS
NATIONAL HOSPICE PALLIATIVE CARE MONTH.**

WHEREAS, hospice and palliative care empowers people facing a serious or life-limiting illness to live as fully as possible, surrounded and supported by family and loved ones; and

WHEREAS, through pain management and symptom control, caregiver training and assistance, and emotional and spiritual support, allowing patients to live fully and make more meaningful moments until the end, surrounded and supported by the faces of loved ones, friends, and committed caregivers; and

WHEREAS, every year more than 1.5 to 1.6 million Americans living with life-limiting illnesses, and their families received care from the nation's hospice programs in communities throughout the United States; and



In 1976, the Levy County Board of County Commissioners formed a committee of volunteers to compile a history of Levy County in celebration of the American Bicentennial. A group of interested volunteers formed the Levy County Archives Committee and over the years compiled and published 28 volumes of county history.

At the September 22, 2009 meeting of the BOCC, the Commissioners recognized the dissolution of the Levy County Archives Committee upon adoption of Ordinance 2009-42. By BOCC approval, maintenance of the archive's records was transferred to the Levy County Historical Society.

The archive's records, with the permission of Oz Barker, Levy County Property Appraiser, were transferred to a storage area within his offices. Copies of **Search for Yesterday** were made available for purchase at each of Levy County's Public Libraries.

The Historical Society requests permission to have these records digitized and the left over volumes placed in the Levy County Courthouse Lobby for distribution to the
