**EMERGENCY DECLARATION
2017-028**

WHEREAS, the Chair of the Levy County Board of County Commissioners ("Board") approved Emergency Declaration Numbers 2017-018, 2017-021, 2017-024, 2017-025, and 2017-027, of which the Board ratified Emergency Declaration Numbers 2017-018, 2017-021, 2017-024 and 2017-025, which Emergency Declarations declared and extended a local state of emergency based upon drought and wildfire conditions in the County; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida Forest Service has provided information to the County that the Keetch-Byram Drought Index in Levy County has dropped to levels so that drought and wildfire conditions no longer pose a threat to Levy County; and

WHEREAS, based on a request from the State of Florida Forest Service made as a result of the information that drought and wildfire conditions no longer pose a threat to Levy County, and based upon consultation between the County Coordinator, State of Florida Forest Service, and the County Emergency Management Director, it is in the best interests of the County that the local state of emergency declared and extended by the above-referenced Emergency Declarations now be rescinded; and


NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered that:


