Sealed bids for the Hurricane Hermine Damage Repairs will be received at the Board of County Commissioners' Office, located at Levy County 355 South Court Street Bronson, FL 32621-6520, until 2:00 PM, local time, **Thursday, August 24, 2017** and there, at said office, at said time, publicly opened and read aloud. Bids shall be submitted in a sealed envelope clearly marked "Hurricane Hermine Damage Repairs".

The project generally consists of the repairs of the following airfield items that were damaged during the passage of Hurricane Hermine: Embankment, Chain Link Fence, Wind Sock, Airfield Sign, and REILS. The project will be bid as a Base Bid only. Prevailing wage rates apply. Contractors must be bonded and insured to the level indicated in the Contract Documents. A Federal DBE participation goal is included in the Contract.
